C.588 Future Governance of the Town Hall

Mr. Peter White, Fresh Life Consultancy, assisted by Mr. David Alcock, Anthony Collins Solicitors LLP, gave a presentation to the Council on the options for the future governance of the Town Hall. After the presentation the following points were made: -

- The proposed governance model of a trust would still mean the Town Council retained overall responsibility for the Town Hall
- The trust was a common model across local authorities and gave the best support to attract grant funding for the future
- The work to deliver the trust can be completed to match up with the proposed timescale for the HLF grant application

After further discussion it was

RESOLVED: - that, with regard to the Town Hall, the Town Council agree in principle to: -

- i. Set up a charitable company with a trading subsidiary
- ii. Transfer Kidderminster Town Hall on a long term lease and long term agreement for usage
- iii. Prepare the appropriate documentation and registration in advance of the proposed capital works on the Town Hall
- iv. Report back to the Town Council, post the 2021 local elections, to formally confirm the setting up of the charitable company with a trading subsidiary
