Town Hall

Works have been progressing at the Town Hall. Key activities during this period include:

- Attic strengthening works started
- Drainage and foundation works completed, ready for canopy installation
- Roof restoration significantly progressed
- Bell Tower stone works completed
- Completed existing kitchen structural opening 70% of the scaffolding has been dismantled, remaining scaffold carry out additional stone work repairs
- Ventilation to music hall and basement has progressed with attic and basement installations.

Key works to be progressed over the next month include:

- Balcony lift works to begin
- A fully costed and agreed design to be in place by the end of September 2024
- Music room ceiling repairs to be completed and painted
- Audio visual systems to be installed
- Tiling in toilets to begin
