Project Summary

Speller Metcalfe are delivering the transformation of the historic Grade II listed, Kidderminster Town Hall on behalf of the Town Council

The redevelopment includes a complete refurbishment of the café area, transforming it into an indoor/outdoor space which can be further divided into separate areas for group entertainment.

In the music hall, the historic ceiling is being restored alongside refurbishment of the floor, and the stage being brought up to modern performance standards alongside sound and lighting upgrades. The Town Hall has also secured funding to have the rare organ pipework professionally cleaned.

Throughout the building there will be upgrades to the mechanical and electrical services, installation of a new lift, improved disabled entrances and refurbishment of the ground floor toilet areas. The King Charles suite roof is also being restored with improvements in insulation features to make the room more energy efficient and welcoming.

Finally, the project team will be restoring and cleaning the heritage features outside of the Town Hall to ensure they continue to stand the test of time.
