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An Ambitious Project Several Years In The Making

After a £12 million redevelopment, the Town Hall has welcomed its first live bands.

Renovations at Kidderminster Town Hall have been ongoing since January. The Grade II-listed building is undergoing major upgrades, including a refurbished café area, new dressing rooms, and other improvements.

Mathew Horne and Imagine Lennon have so far performed in the new Music Room, ahead of the official launch event on 7th November.

Described as a “game changer” by Town Hall Manager Matt Smith, the new facilities will attract talent from the UK and beyond, putting Kidderminster back on the entertainment map.



Town Hall Re-Opening

The Grand Re-Opening takes place on 7th November with the Mayor of Kidderminster welcoming many of those who took part in the redevelopment.

An exclusive performance from Blind Lemon will follow the opening ceremony.

Guests will be able to see first-hand the result of the last few years' developments, including the music hall, the courtyard, bars and cafes.
