Seasonal Works Update

We look after 3 parks within Kidderminster: Broadwaters Mill, Baxter Gardens and St George's.

Our spring and summer works have now been completed, and we are moving into our winter works programme. Over the coming months, this will include reducing and tidying hedgerows, edging footpaths, and carrying out a deep clean of park furniture.

We will also be undertaking planting and general tidying of beds, alongside essential tree works to maintain safety and support long-term health of our green spaces.




<u>Climate Emergency</u>

Kidderminster Town Council members unanimously approved a "Climate Emergency Action Plan", with the aim of making the Town Council carbon neutral by 2035.



The Town Mayor, Cllr Doug Hine, said: "The introduction to our plan briefly outlines the urgent and significant threat posed by Climate Change. With this plan we join with over 600 councils across Britain – big and small – covering 96% of the population who are setting ambitious targets and taking meaningful action."

Cllr John Beckingham, Chairman of the Council's Operational Services Committee said, "Not only are the measures in our plan beneficial to the planet, but they will save Kidderminster Town Council and our residents money through energy and waste efficiencies; and contribute to our vision of healthy and happy neighbourhoods".


